

President's Message

Congratulations to director Ann Davis, the cast, and the crew of *Farce of Nature* for presenting such a funny and highly successful production, which was enjoyed by over 1100 patrons. Next up is *Collective Dating* which opens on January 16, 2026. Auditions and casting have already been completed, and rehearsals began on November 24, 2025. A full listing of the cast appears in another section of this newsletter.

The November 17th Monday Night Gathering, which served as our "members only" annual business meeting, was attended by 57 of our current membership of 190, which was more than enough needed for a quorum. The results of the gathering were as follows:

- The revised Rules and Regs were approved with the caveat that recommended language changes be incorporated by the February 2026 Monday Night Gathering, with another vote to be taken then to approve these changes
- Jean Balk, outgoing treasurer, presented the 2025-26 budget, along with a report on the financial results of the 2024-25 season. She also offered a list of capital purchases made by the club during this fiscal year. The new budget was passed by a unanimous voice vote.
- Ann Davis and Lesley Watson were elected in a landslide for the two vacant executive board positions. Thanks to both for coming forward to serve us in these important roles.

We owe a special thank you to Jean Balk, who has looked over the club finances for many years. We are certainly appreciative of all her efforts.

The 2026/27 season will be our last at the current Mountain View auditorium location, as demolition and reconstruction of a new Performing Arts Center (PAC) is slated to begin sometime between January 1 to April 1, 2027. Although there is much to be excited about the prospect of a beautiful,

new PAC, questions such as where we will meet, where the stage will be and where all our props and supplies will be stored are a concern to all of us. Our PAC transition committee, chaired by Tom Swenson, is diligently exploring all possibilities. At a productive meeting with Mike Dirmyer, RCSC Facilities Manager, we were encouraged by the corporation's acknowledgement and interest that we will need their help in finding a temporary facility.

As we move into December, I am so proud to be involved with our Players club. It is an honor to work with so many talented, caring and dedicated people. I wish you all a happy and prosperous holiday season. Looking forward to seeing you at the holiday party on December 7, 2025.
